Dear Dr. Chakrabarty,

At the recommendation of the Associate Dean of Clinical Medicine, I am pleased to grant you an appointment as Adjunct Clinical Faculty in the Department of Clinical Medicine at the Arkansas College of Osteopathic Medicine. This appointment is effective until 7/28/2023 and is renewable for additional academic years at the discretion of the Associate Dean of Clinical Medicine and upon approval of the Dean. You will be paid \$500/student/month for Core and Selective rotations.

Adjunct Clinical faculty members are expected to teach ARCOM medical students under the direction of your Department Chair and the Associate Dean of Clinical Medicine. To maintain your appointment as "Adjunct Faculty", you must precept 9 students over 3 years, if you are unable to meet the adjunct requirement, you may continue to train students as a preceptor. If your appointment requires teaching in the clinical setting, it is contingent upon maintaining an unrestricted license to practice in the appropriate state and maintaining appropriate clinical privileges at practice sites. ARCOM does not provide oversight or direction in connection with your medical practice. You also agree to maintain adequate malpractice insurance coverage for your professional practice.

You may allow assigned trainees to participate in rendering medical care to your patient, but they may do so only under your direct supervision. ARCOM will ensure that students have appropriate malpractice insurance coverage for any patient care assistance they may provide under your direction and supervision.

It is my honor to bestow this title upon you as a reflection of the value that the ARCOM faculty and administration place upon you. I wish to personally thank you for your ongoing support of ARCOM and our students.
