Subject: Request for 100 Ventilators (50 for AarogyaSeva 100 Bed Field Hospital in Jayanagar and 50 for redistribution to partner hospitals listed below)

Aarogya Seva is an international, humanitarian sustainable micro-volunteering platform that is dedicated to providing quality healthcare services to affected communities worldwide. It is a section 8 not for profit company in India and a 501(c)3 non profit in USA founded in 2014.

The situation in India is getting worse though there is overwhelming support and we are working hard to curb the challenges. As a doctor and public health worker in the field the experiences are frustrating and heartbreaking but stories of hope and encouragement are what is keeping the volunteer force afloat.

With increasing demand for beds, oxygen concentrators, ICU, spread of the double mutant and many of the doctors testing positive and being out of action we are sending out an appeal for help. We are working closely with several partners, NGOs, Task forces, governments and volunteers in Bangalore and tier 2 and 3 towns in Karnataka.

We are fully credentialed and due diligence compliant for any CSR and all donors. There is also a lot of miscommunication and misuse of this appeal letter. As a member of the IndiaCOVIDSoS TaskForce we are also building a consortium of regional hospitals, pharma and equipment distributors, supply chain, logistics etc to work together in achieving 1000 ICU beds in Karnataka in tier 2 and tier 3 cities. We are also looking at setting up oxygen beds in hospitals in a 100 km radius of Bangalore to cope and prepare as the wave that is already reaching outside Bangalore. we are setting up mobile ICU's, Oxygen generators, concentrators, new make shift hospital set ups. We also have a strong network of medical and non medical volunteers on the ground.

We have a consolidated needs list of some smaller field hospitals in tier 2 and 3 towns that need to build capacity immediately as the city is overwhelmed and the government is now issuing passes for patients to be taken outside. These ventilators will be used free of cost to serve the underserved and marginalized communities and not be resold. This will be added as an asset to these hospitals doing yeoman service.
